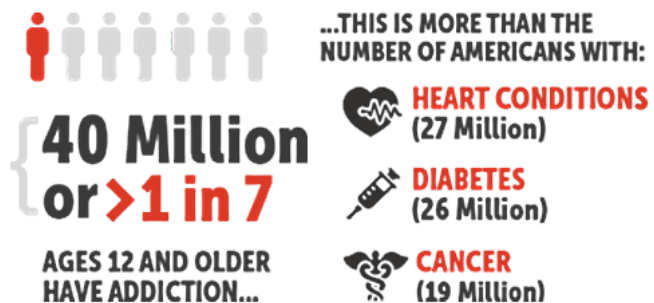

The Hope in Recovery J.O.B.S. (Just Online Being Sober) Program

The social and economic impact of substance abuse and addiction is staggering. Lives are lost, families are torn apart and corporations lose billions. It simply effects everyone and every company, directly or indirectly.

Our programs are designed to provide hope and support for individuals following an addiction treatment program that are currently under- or unemployed. The Hope in Recovery J.O.B.S Program is a 2-month paid part time internship for a person in recovery experiencing barriers to re-entering the workforce. It is an opportunity to build a foundation of basic technology skills in a friendly, safe, sober and supportive environment. We will work with these individuals to develop the technology skills necessary for them to sell items online or find a career path requiring them to be competent technically. Online opportunity tracks include selling items on various online auction and storefront platforms, social media management or even creative content with video and graphics. Goal setting and selling skills will be an integral part of their professional development. My Recovery Day coaches will help bring out the value that is already there in each of them.



What Are the Skillsets Individuals Will Learn?

- Keyboarding – online learning and certification through our “TypingClub”_membership
- General Technology Overview of Computers and the Internet
- Digital Photography and Basic Graphics Editing
- A Review of Social Media Platforms and Using Them Effectively
- How to Sell an Item Online and What Platforms Can Be used

What Are the Goals for Each Individual?

- **Sustained Recovery.** First and foremost, our vision for every individual in recovery is to stay in recovery with confidence, purpose and passion. We talk recovery everyday throughout the day.
- **Gainful Employment.** Using technology skills learned at My Recovery Day, we can help with career guidance and resume building. Since these individuals will be employed at My Recovery Day, they can pursue looking for a career with confidence.
- **Entrepreneur Path.** The Ability to Earn Money Online with a goal of earning \$25K to \$35k per year by selling donated items online.

What Does the Sponsorship Pay For?

- Individual Compensation: Recipients are guaranteed \$14/hour (and related taxes); 20 hours/week for 8 weeks {plus “Revenue Share”}. Individuals will be required to learn skills through online tutorials in their off time and can begin to sell items online to earn more than the hourly rate. Individuals can work more than the paid 20 hours per week to increase their income through Revenue Sharing on product sales.
- Subscription Fees for Online Training Tutorials: Keyboarding (Typing), Photoshop, etc.
- A Dedicated Coach experienced in Online Sales to teach and mentor each individual
- Technology Support – Use of Digital Cameras/phones and Recording Equipment, Editing and Listing Software, Computers and Internet
- All Supplies – Tools, cleaning and packing materials
- General Warehouse and Office Space

What is My Sponsorship Investment in Each Individual Internship?

The Investment in an individual is only \$5000. You can sponsor more than one individual.

How Do I Know the Funds Will Be Used for the Intended Purpose?

My Recovery Day will tell you who the individual recipient is and supply a progress report to you at the end of 8 weeks along with their 8-week payroll report. The majority of the funds are paid directly to the employee.

What if the Individual Does Not Complete the Internship?

Careful screening of applicants along with a full disclosure of expectations will help us select the best candidates with the highest probability to gain from the opportunity. Although we do not anticipate individuals dropping out before completion, it can occur for a variety of reasons. The assigned coach is also responsible for the individuals progress and making sure they meet and/or exceeds their goals.

What if the Individual Does Not Complete the Internship?

Careful screening of applicants, along with a full disclosure of expectations, will help prevent dropouts.
